

Sections

This tournament is open to all junior players. The age on 1st September, 2018, should be used when entering a section. There will be the following sections:

Under 11 Group A: Open
Under 11 Group B: ECF Grade Under 75
Under 11 Group C: ECF Grade Under 50
Under 11 Group D: ECF Grade Under 25
Under 18 Group A: Open
Under 18 Group B: ECF Grade Under 100

The organiser will put ungraded players in the most appropriate section for them.

Note: The January 2019 grades may be available by this date. If they are available in enough time to do the necessary administration for the tournament, they will be used, and children will be moved up or down sections accordingly depending on their new grade.

Entry Fee £12.50

Entries on the day will be at the organiser's discretion and subject to a £12.50 surcharge.

ECF Membership
