WORLD JUNIOR CHAMPIONSHIPS

BELFORT, FRANCE

The World Junior Championships have just ended, with a full complement of 10 competitors representing England in the 5 age groups U10, U12, U14, U16 & U18, one of each gender.

Craig Whitfield scored a creditable 6/10, playing several FIDE rated players, to post the best ever score by an England U10 boy. Li Wu, formerly of Warwickshire, scored a marvelous 7.5/10 in the U16 boys' event, his well in contention for a medal until the later stages. Stephanie Hale, whose family is moving to Northamptonshire, scored a creditable 4.5/10 in the U10 Girls section. All the other non-Midlands competitors scored more than 50%, and most players performed better than their predicted score.

It was not ideal that the annual U18 European team events overlapped with the World Championships. However, the fact that England retained both cups, demonstrates that we have some strength in depth.

A considerable proportion of the England players were Midlands based players. Simon Fowler of Shropshire was the England Board 1, with Richard Westwood of Staffordshire & Paul Lam of Warwickshire boards 4 & 5 respectively in the 5 man team. They competed against teams from Scotland, Ireland, Wales, Belgium and the Czech Republic.

Charlotte Wilcox from Staffordshire was the England A team board 3 and Hannah Dale of Lincolnshire the B team board 2. An England C team made up of local Liverpool girls also played, in order to provide an even number of teams. The England opposition came from Ireland, Belgium and the Czech Republic.

NATIONAL CLUB FINALS

Report from Cyril Johnson

Again the National Club Finals split between two venues. The Minor Championship was played at Queniborough Village Hall, where Lancaster beat Hammersmith with the final game going to the last few seconds. The rest of the Finals were played at the Golden Lane Community Centre courtesy of London Chess League and Brian Smith.

The Open was the expected triumph for Wood Green. The Minor between Lancaster and Hammersmith was so close for much of the match that discussions were held as to what would happen if all 5 boards were drawn. Eventually as with the Major Plate Championship with Hounslow and South Norwood an unfortunate blunder decided the match. The Minor Plate saw Newark win comfortably, helped by their opponents conceding a board.

The players were somewhat amused and honoured by a fly pass of vintage aeroplanes. The event was well controlled by David Sedgwick and the Director of Home Chess thanked everyone for their support over the years.

COUNTY TEAM FINALS REPORT

The County Championships returned to the first venue used by the retiring Controller, to the large, well appointed Sports Hall at Ratcliffe College, with room to walk between all the boards.

Lancashire and Manchester contested the Open Championship, with the Mancunians retaining their trophy by 11-5, with Harry Lamb winning the Best Game Prize for his win on board 16 (see main newsletter). The Minor Counties Championship saw Derbyshire make a rare Finals appearance, but lose 9-7 to defending Champions Norfolk. The U175 were without their defending Champions, but Devon were worthy winners on the day against another Lancashire team by 9½ to 6½. The U150s saw the closest finish of the day, with the retiring controller watching two adjacent boards on which a player had claimed a draw under Article 10.2 Both games were drawn, leaving a drawn match with Notts the winners over Norfolk on board count.

Lancashire were successful in the U125s beating Middlesex 11-5. The U100s saw Essex win against another county who do not often grace the finals, Staffordshire. The Bursar of the College, Mr Andrew Nutter, presented the prizes, with the assistance of Roy Heppinstal, the BCF CEO. The Director of Home Chess made an impassioned plea for someone to take over the running of this event. Thanks were expressed to the controlling team, Messrs Shaw, Elwin and Cresswell and to the Browns of Sharnford who assisted with the compiling of results.
